

And saviours shall come up

What is the word Saviours in Obadiah 1:21 mean?

Obadiah 1:21 And saviours shall come up on mount Zion to judge the mount of Esau; and the kingdom shall be the LORD'S. [941]

This verse describes the glory of Israel after Edom and all the other nations have fallen

Mount Zion--a specific mountain near Jerusalem—city of David.. “Zion” was eventually used as a name for the city of Jerusalem, the land of Judah, and the people of Israel as a whole

2 Samuel 5:7 [360]

Psalms 48:2 [621]

Isaiah 60:14 [765]

Proverbs 29:2 [693]When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice: but when the wicked beareth rule, the people mourn.

Revelation 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them; and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

Mount of Esau

Genesis 36:9 And these *are* the generations of Esau the father of the Edomites in mount Seir:

Judge rules

Our federal government has three parts. They are the Executive, Legislative (Senate and House of Representatives) and Judicial (Supreme Court and lower Courts). In your Bible this is NOT the form of government.

Hebrews 10:30 For we know him that hath said, Vengeance *belongeth* unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord **shall judge his people.**

Matthew 19:28

Luke 19:15-19

If you compare Obadiah with Joel 2:30-32

Joel 2:30-32 [932] And I will shew wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke. The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of the LORD come. And it shall come to pass, *that* whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the LORD hath said, and in the remnant whom the LORD shall call.

In Israel history between Joshua and Saul, there were judges ruling—same sense as this word saviours.

Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph → 400 years, Moses, Joshua **Judges (Sampson, Deborah, Gideon, Battle of Jericho)**, Saul, David, Solomon

Judges 2:16 [289] Nevertheless the LORD raised up judges, which delivered them out of the hand of those that spoiled them.

Judges 2:18 And when the LORD raised them up judges, then the **LORD was with the judge, and** delivered them out of the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge: for it repented the LORD because of their groanings by reason of them that oppressed them and vexed them.

Judges 3:9 And when the children of Israel cried unto the LORD, the LORD raised up a deliverer to the children of Israel, who delivered them, *even* Othniel the son of Kenaz, Caleb's younger brother.

Judges 3:15 But when the children of Israel cried unto the LORD, the LORD raised them up a deliverer, Ehud the son of Gera, a Benjamite, a man lefthanded: and by him the children of Israel sent a present unto Eglon the king of Moab.

Another example of a savior out of a situation.

2 Kings 13:5 [487] (And the LORD gave Israel a saviour,

This saviour was undoubtedly Joash, whose successful wars are subsequently detailed

2 Kings 13:25 And Jehoash ... Three times did Joash beat him, **and recovered the cities of Israel.**

2 Kings 14:25 He restored the coast of Israel...

2 Kings 14:27 And the LORD said not that he would blot out the name of Israel from under heaven: but **he saved them by the hand of Jeroboam the son of Joash.**

Obadiah 1:21 And saviours shall come up on mount Zion to judge the mount of Esau; and the kingdom shall be the LORD'S.
